All abstracts and surgical films must be submitted online. Visit the Abstract Submission page to view the topics, quidelines and access the submission portal. The submission quidelines document found on the web page will answer many of your questions and the submission portal takes you through the process step by step. Although there is no limit to the number of submitted abstracts, each individual can be assigned as a presenter of a maximum of five (5) abstracts. Notification of acceptance of late-breaking abstracts will occur by Mid-July. Further instructions regarding presentation specifics will be sent at the time of the acceptance letter. Selected abstracts will be assigned to different presentation categories such as oral presentations, IGCS poster talks, printed poster presentations and others. Visit the Abstract Submission page for further details and guidelines. The abstract submission deadline is now closed.

There will be no extensions for submission deadlines. Latebreaking submission is now closed. Accepted abstracts will be assigned to one of the following categories: (1) oral presentations in plenary sessions; (2) IGCS poster talks; (3) featured printed poster presentations; (4) E-Poster viewing; (5) featured surgical film presentations; (6) on-demand surgical film cinema.

Presenters of an oral abstract in a plenary session will be provided with instructions for the live session along with the date and time of the session(s). Details, specifications, and instructions for each presentation type will be sent with the

acceptance letters in mid-June. Individuals chosen to present surgical films will receive presentation details in mid-June as well. Yes. The presenting author of an accepted abstract or film must be registered for the meeting by the deadline specified in their acceptance notification.

Industry employees' participation as presenters in the scientific program is only allowed if they agree to speak only on completely non-commercial topics, unrelated to any of their company's products, such as:

- basic science research (e.g. pre-clinical research, or therapy discovery)
- 2. process or methodologies of research unrelated to a specific disease or device
- 3. mechanisms of action unrelated to a specific product

Abstract submission is now closed. As long as the abstract represents new and unpublished data on your trial-in-progress, you can submit it for the IGCS 2024 Meeting.IGCS does not accept case reports as abstracts at this time. Please note, as per the IGCS 2024 Abstract Submission Guidelines, submitted abstracts must represent new, unpublished scientific data at the time of presentation.
